Q.1 What is present continuous tense? Ans. We use the present continuous tense to talk about things which are happening now.

Q. 2 What is present perfect tense?

Ans. We use the present perfect tense for actions in the past when we are not thinking or talking about the exact time that they happened. Sentence in the present perfect tense connect the past and the present in same way.

Q. 3 What is present perfect continuous tense?

Ans. We use the present perfect continuous tense to talk about action which began at sometime in the past and are still going on.

Q. 4 What is past continuous tense?

Ans. We use the past continuous tense for an action which was in the middle of happening at a particular time in the past.

Q. 5 What is future tense?

Ans. We use the simple future to talk about what we think or know will happen in the future.
